HISTORY OF ANKUR SCHOOL

The idea of having a Nursery School on the Campus of Panjab University was a long cherished dream of the residents, so all the members of the Student Aid Society met and discussed the possibility and finally decided to work in this direction.

Mrs. Suraj Bhan carried on the idea of free school in the campus for the junior employee's children.

The PU Student Aid Society then embarked upon establishing Nursery School on modern lines, to provide quality education to young ones from the very start. The purpose was to fulfill long felt need of the parents residing in the campus as well as in the adjacent sector, for a Nursery school. It was thus, a welfare activity on the campus in the true sense of the term. Thus, Student Aid Society has remained a parent body. The school was named Ankur Nursery School, which got formally inaugurated on 25th February, 1973.

2. To collect funds through donations, subscriptions, film shows in the university campus, dramas and organizing fetes etc, for providing aid to needy students.
3. To foster a spirit of social service amongst the members.

A number of welfare schemes were introduced to ensure quality education in the school.

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

Parents are apprised of the examination system at the time of the orientation meeting. The students are given circular regarding the detail of the examination in the beginning of the session along with the marking scheme.

Classes I-VIII

- ◆ Pre Mid-Term examination in the first/second week of July.
- ◆ Mid-Term examination in Mid September.
- ◆ Post Mid-Term examination in the second/third week of December
- ◆ Annual Examination in the third week of February.

Classes IX-X

- ◆ Pre Mid-Term examination in the first/second week of July.
- ◆ Mid-Term examination in Mid September.
- ◆ Post Mid-Term examination in the second/third week of December.
- ◆ Pre Annual (IX) and Pre-Board (X) in the second week of January.
- ◆ Annual Exam in the third week of February for Class IX.
- ◆ Class X students to appear for the Board Examination in the second week of February.

Classes XI-XII

- ◆ Unit Test-I in May (Class XII) and in July (Class XI).
- ◆ Half yearly examination in mid September.
- ◆ Unit Test-II in the second/third week of December.
- ◆ Annual Exam in the first week of February for Class XI.
- ◆ New Session for Class XII starts in the first week of March.
- ◆ Pre-Board for Class XII in the second week of January.
- ◆ Class XII students to appear for the Board Examination in the second week of February.

ATTENDANCE

In order to be eligible for appearing in class X and XII board examination as per CBSE rules, a student must have attended not less than 75% of the classes held in each subject. Students attaining 100% attendance for the academic session will get the certificate for their regularity.

SCHOOL DIARY

The 'Student Diary' forms an important means of communication between the parents and the teacher. Parents must sign the diary every day. It not only contains the personal information, medical history of a child but also the code of conduct and school rules. Information about the school uniform, timing and other vital information can also be obtained from the school diary/almanac.

TIME TABLE & CALENDAR

The school organizes its curriculum on a six days basis. Detail of periods and subjects are given in the time table on the first day of the New academic session. An annual calendar is issued to the students and parents. It gives information about exam days, holidays, festivals, non teaching days, vacations, annual events, house activities and competitions etc. All Saturdays are off for the Pre primary wing but for classes 1st to 10+2, only 2nd & 4th Saturdays are off.



SCHOLARSHIPS/INCENTIVES/AWARDS IN SPORTS

The bright and deserving students in academics as well as sports are awarded with various scholarships and awards.

- 1) Smt. Maitreyi Sharma Memorial Award for the Best student of Nursery class (one time cash prize of Rs. 500/-)
- 2) Seth Beni Prasad Memorial Award for the Best student of K.G. Class (one time cash prize of Rs.500/-)
- 3) Dr. Kuljeet Singh Ahluwalia Memorial Award for the Best student of Class 1 (one time cash prize of Rs.1000/-)

- ◆ For State level winner, cash prize of Rs. 250/- is given as scholarship per month. Along with, a merit certificate, a trophy and colour for the blazer for one year is also given during the period when the student holds position as State level winner.



ACADEMIC AWARDS

- Scholar badges are pinned up to all the students securing 90% and above marks in one academic session.
- Students getting the scholar badges for three consecutive years are given some incentive in the form of school bags or some good library books at the time of prize distribution ceremony.
- The student attaining 100% attendance in an academic year are awarded with certificates.

Highly qualified and experienced staff has been appointed for teaching classes 10+1 & 10+2. A large number of reference books have been added to the library. 1. Change of subject is allowed only within first month of the academic session in class XI.
2. No Change of subject is allowed in XII (allowed only in special cases)
3. The child can also choose any of the optional subjects offered above as additional or sixth subject.

REGISTRATION & ADMISSION PROCESS

Application for admission in the school must be made on the prescribed form attached with the prospectus.

Documents Required

- Copy of the Birth certificate with name.
- Two passport size photographs of the child, mother & father each.
- Residence proof (self attested).
- Copy of the Aadhar Card (Optional).
- Copy of the Vaccination Card/Immunization Card.

A) ADMISSION TO NURSERY

- The admission will be given on the basis of draw as per orders of the District Education Office of U.T. Chandigarh.
- Seats have been reserved for the wards of employees of PU and colleges affiliated to it.
- Seats reserved for E.W.S. (25%).

B) ADMISSION FROM CLASSES L.K.G. TO IX

Admission to these classes depends on the availability of seats.

C) ADMISSION TO CLASS XI (COMMERCE AND ARTS ONLY)

- For class XI:** Provisional admission to be given in the beginning on the basis of pre board result.
- Total Number of Seats:** 40 (in each of the streams).
- School Timings:** 8.00 am to 12.30 pm (in Summer)
8.30 am to 1.00 pm (in Winter)
- All the Saturdays will be working for Class XI except second & Fourth Saturdays.
- Criteria for Admission :**
For The Internal Candidates:
 - 60% Marks in Board for admission to Arts.
 - 65% Marks in Board exam for admission to Commerce.**For the External Candidates:**
 - 65% Marks in Board exam for admission to Arts.
 - 70% Marks in Board exam for admission to Commerce.

RULES FOR WITHDRAWAL

- A student who wishes to leave the school must apply in writing to the Principal.
- The application must be countersigned by the parents.
- A month's notice or one month's fee in lieu has to be paid when a student is to be withdrawn.
- Those who leave the school in May, must in all cases pay the fee for the month of June of the current academic session.
- School leaving certificates will be issued only after the student has cleared all the dues.
- Caution money will be refunded on clearing of all the dues.
- Caution money if not claimed within 6 months of withdrawal of the child shall be forfeited. This money will be spent for the welfare of the students.
- For further detail, refer to the school almanac.

DISCIPLINE RULES

- The motto of the school is discipline & efficiency. We expect loyalty and sincerity from the student at all the times.
- Students are expected to be polite to one another and show respect to their teachers and class IV employees of the school. Strict action will be taken if rules are not followed. Parents will be called in case of a serious matter.
- When in school, students are expected to communicate in English and not in Hindi and mother tongue.
- Defacing the walls/school property like furniture, electrical appliances, pipes tapes etc. will be treated as a misconduct and will invite action against the defaulters.

LEAVE AND RE-ADMISSION

- (1) Leave must be applied on a printed application form attached in the school diary as supplied by the school. In case of sickness and post dated sanction, certificate from a qualified doctor is must.
- (2) Name of the student will be struck off the rolls of the school in case there is an unexplained, continuous absence for 10 days or leave having not obtained in advance. Genuine cases will always be considered with compassion. (kindly check the fee booklet also for the rules)
- (3) In case of re-admission he/she can be re-admitted by paying re-admission fee as mentioned in the fee booklet.
- (4) Short leave for any one hour allowed only in case of an emergency.
